II. League Business

1. State Cup Recap—Claudella Wright: Claudella reported on the results of State Cup, both Over 30 and Open, and explained the possible locations for next year.
2. Fundraising: The captains determined that the tournament moved to summer; a there was a discussion for a need for a committee during the fall/spring to come up with fundraising ideas; a need for a tournament committee was also discussed so we can maximize funds received for the tournament next time.
3. Land—Marla Broaddus: Marla explained the situation with the County and City and the need for the league to continue to raise money and study options for developing land. The land owned by the YMCA was discussed. The captains requested that fees for team registration be raised by up to \$100 next Fall so that more money can be raised. The captains do not want to continue only paying the minimum to cover costs.
